## **Camoplast ICE Series Continues To Improve and Expand**

Camoplast Inc., the world's largest manufacturer of snowmobile tracks, continues their mission to improve snowmobiling by providing better performing tracks for snowmobile enthusiasts. And this season the company further expands and improves the exclusive Ice Control Enhancement (ICE) Technology pre-studded track series.

Introduced in 2004 with the one-inch lug ICE Claw track in two models, the ICE Technology series offers a turnkey solution to riders who want the safety and performance benefits of a studded track without all the drawbacks. These benefits include quicker acceleration, better traction to climb icy hills, fewer spin-outs on icy corners, and especially better braking. Studded tracks can reduce stopping distances by half or more depending on surface conditions.

Now there are nine different ICE Technology tracks to fit a variety of late model machines. ICE Ripper™ models are derived from the very popular RipSaw design. The new ICE Ripper XT and HackSaw™-derived ICE Attak™ models feature the new "sharp tip" lug stud that provides improved traction on ice and hard packed snow. The number of lug studs installed in ICE Technology tracks has grown from 240 in the original Ice Claw to the ICE Attak's 264 points. This provides the ICE Attak with the most scratch lines from any ICE Technology track. Some ICE Technology tracks now carry as many as 341 ice-grabbing lug studs.

ICE Technology models are available for most popular single-seaters with standard 121-inch tracks, Arctic Cat and Polaris models with 128-inch tracks, and the new Ski-doo XP models with 2.86-inch drive pitch tracks in 120- and 137-inch lengths. ICE Technology tracks are also available in 136-inch lengths for two-up and crossover sleds, and the ICE Wide Track™ 20-by-156-inch model is engineered for utility models. And all are backed with a Camoplast limited warranty.

Camoplast tracks equip ninety percent of all snowmobiles on the trail today, and are available as aftermarket performance upgrades from better snowmobile dealers in snow country worldwide.
